Fairfield, CT – June 2008 – Wildlife artist Guy Combes, son of legendary wildlife and landscape painter Simon Combes, kicks off the summer with his annual show at The Greenwich Workshop Gallery. Guy has been hard at work in his post as the Artist-in-Residence at the Hiram Blauvelt Museum in Oradell, New Jersey and traversing the globe in search of animal subjects. Guy Combes will appear at the gallery in downtown Fairfield, showing his compelling safari scenes and wildlife portraits on opening night, **June 14 from 6-8 PM**. The show will hang for two weeks.

About Guy Combes

Guy Combes was born in Kenya in 1971, the son of artist Simon Combes. After studying in Kenya for several years he moved to the United Kingdom to continue his education. While in school he developed an interest in visual art. He studied art in Cheltenham, England, then at the Inchbald School of Design in London.

After a short stint as a consultant, Guy diverted his attentions to painting commissions and design work. Guy is now based in his home country of Kenya, where he manages tourist lodges and continues to paint commissions and works for exhibition. In November 2006 he began a program as artist-in-residence at the Hiram Blauvelt Art Museum in Oradell, New Jersey.

He is currently studying the history and culture of the Swahili coast of Africa and the diverse wildlife of Kenya. Throughout 2006 Guy visited Australia, New Zealand, Japan, Europe and the United States and will include observations from these trips in his portfolio.
