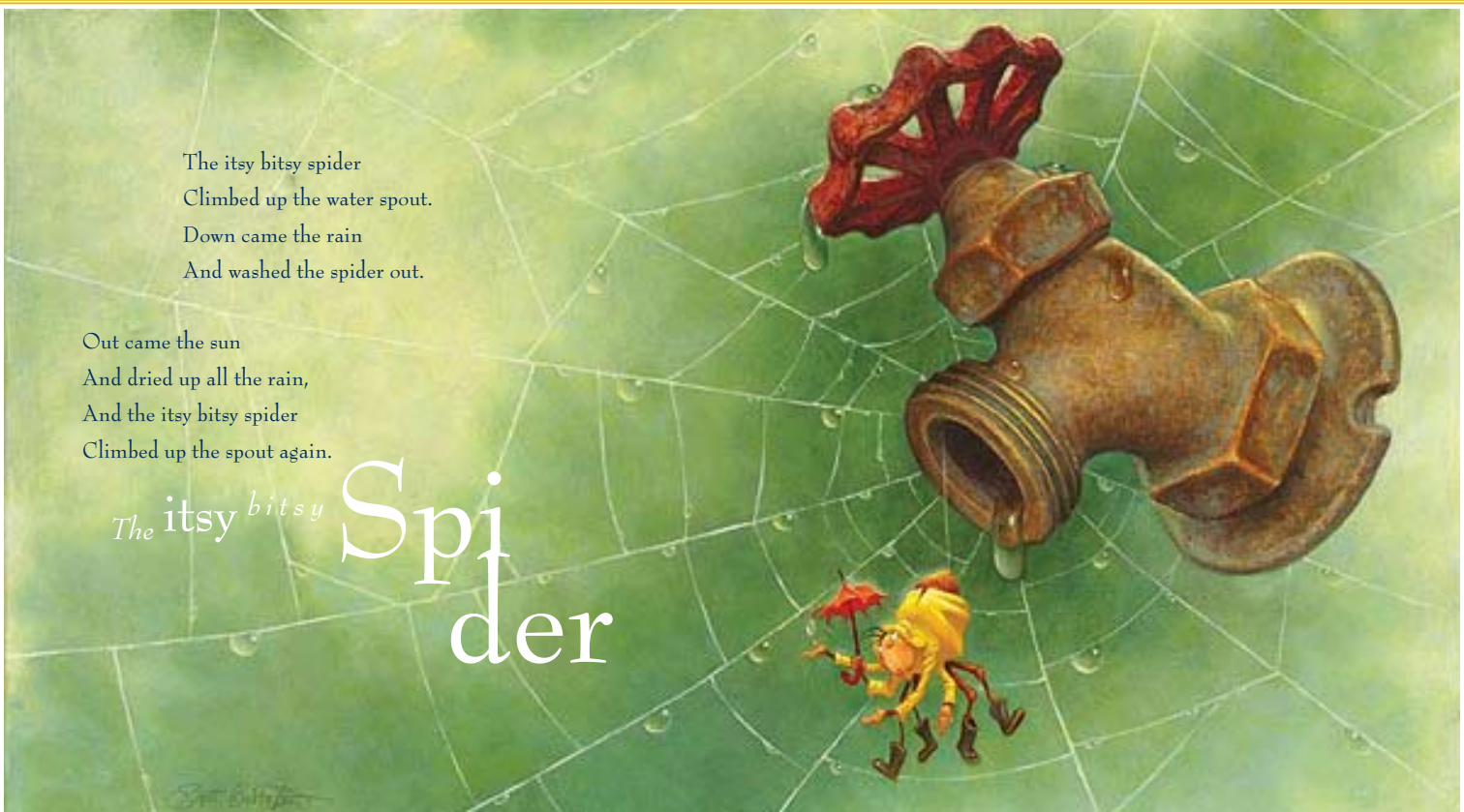
# Humpty Dumpty
